Dear Members,

The weather continues to be spectacular for this time of year. The golf course has been open for walking only in January and February. Many of the full time residents have taken advantage of the good weather getting a few early rounds in. As we continue to prepare for the busy season we want everyone to be aware of a few things.

- **New Head Professional-** Josh Gold will be our new Head Professional. Josh is originally from Phoenix, Arizona and has worked at the Long Bow G.C. as well as the 500 G.C. in the Phoenix area. For the past 5 years Josh has been in the Kalispell, Montana area where he has been at Big Mountain G.C., Golf USA as well as being the High School Golf Coach. Josh brings a lot of experience in Club Management, Teaching and Merchandising. Josh is a great player and will be a terrific asset to our team. His first day will be the 22nd of March.

- **Outside Food and Beverage-** We want to make everyone aware that outside food and beverage is prohibited on the golf course and we will be making a concerted effort to stop this practice by both members and guests. Outside alcoholic beverages on the golf course is a violation of the law, and puts our liquor license in jeopardy. We estimate that the club loses on average between \$40,000 to \$60,000 a year by outside food and beverages being taken onto the golf course.

- **Carts**- We will be opening the Golf Course to carts on March 1st. This will be cart paths only until the 15th of March. At that time we will make a decision on whether or not to allow carts on the fairways.

- **Course Maintenance**- We want to remind everyone it is only March and we will perform minimum maintenance on the course. The main reason for not mowing is the health of the golf course. Most likely we will get more snow and freezing daytime and nighttime temperatures. To assure we keep damage to a minimum we will be monitoring frost, which may delay your starting time.

- **Vote Tally**- There has been a little confusion about the CC&R changes and Vote Tally letter that was sent out earlier. The letter is simply the results of the vote taken last year. The results are in the upper box and may require you to enlarge that section to read it clearly.
